Resident in small animal internal medicine (starting date 01.09.2023)

The internal medicine department of the teaching hospital of Maisons-Alfort (CHUVA, Centre hospitalier universitaire vétérinaire d'Alfort) offers 1 position for a 3 to 4 years training program structured according to the guidelines of, and approved by, the ECVIM-CA.

The resident will take primary responsibility for small animal Internal Medicine cases. He/she will be scheduled to take part in the primary emergency duty rotation of the Veterinary Teaching Hospital. The resident will be involved in clinical teaching to students and in advising interns. External rotations (in France and abroad) are part of the program. The Resident will also take part to one or several clinical research studies. The program is under supervision of 3 ECVIM Diplomate and 1 National Specialist in Small Animal Internal Medicine.

Required profile: A European Association of Establishments for Veterinary Education –approved DVM (or equivalent veterinary degree completed with a valid license to work in France) is mandatory. Candidates should have successfully completed a one year rotating internship program (or at least two years of experience in a small animal practice with a dedicated area for internal medicine).

They should be French speaking and be able to efficiently communicate with patient's owners.
