Job Summary

The Purdue University College of Veterinary Medicine (PVM), Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences (VCS), invites applications for TWO full-time (12 month) Clinical or Tenure-track faculty positions in Veterinary Medical Oncology at the Assistant or Associate Professor level. These two new faculty positions have been made possible through a \$10M gift to the PVM to transform the long-standing Purdue Comparative Oncology Program to the Evan and Sue Ann Werling Comparative Oncology Research Center (WCORC) (<https://vet.purdue.edu/wcorc/>). The successful candidate will join a vibrant team that includes three medical oncology and one radiation oncology faculty members and faculty members in related disciplines in the full service Purdue University Veterinary Hospital (PUVH). Oncology is one of four emphasis areas in the PVM, and the comparative oncology program is an integral part of the NCI-Designated Purdue University Institute for Cancer Research (PU-ICR).

(www.cancerresearch.purdue.edu/). Clinical Track faculty members at Purdue University carry academic rank, have a defined promotion system, and enjoy privileges of all faculty members except tenure and sabbatical leave.

Qualifications

Qualifications for the position include a DVM or equivalent degree and board certification or completion of a residency program registered by the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine (ACVIM) or the European College of Veterinary Internal Medicine (ECVIM). Candidates must possess passion for comparative oncology research, and excellent clinical, interpersonal, and communication skills. Salary will be commensurate with the candidate's qualifications and experience. A background check is required for employment by the University.
