

## **Half-time senior clinician position (residency-trained or ECVIM diplomate) in small animal internal medicine**

The Department of Clinical Sciences of Companion Animals, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, **University of Liège, Belgium**, offers a **half-time position as senior clinician (residency-trained or ECVIM-diplomate) in small animal internal medicine, starting September 15, 2023.**

Candidates should have a good knowledge of the English language, and a at least basic knowledge of the French language. The half time period of work can be arranged based on an agreement between the applicants and the service members (e.g. it can be by blocks of weeks or months).

The applicants will take primary responsibility for small animal internal medicine cases. He/she will be involved in clinical teaching to students, and will supervise residents in small animal internal medicine, as well as specialized interns and rotating interns. He/she will be scheduled to take part in the work up of internal medicine cases hospitalised through the emergency service of the hospital, as a supervisor (no first line direct duty service).

The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of the University of Liège is situated outside of the city centre on a hilly slope which represents the start of the beautiful Ardennes. The University has a well-equipped and brand-new hospital: intensive care unit, digital X-ray, ultrasound, CT-scan, MRI, endoscopy (gastrointestinal, respiratory and urethro-cystoscopy), urethral pressure profilometry, .... Caseload for small animals is around 10000 cases a year. The actual team includes diplomates in internal medicine (4 Dipl. ECVIM-CA), in cardiology (1 ECVIM-Cardiology), in neurology (1 part time Dipl.ECVN), surgery (5 Dipl. ECVS), emergency and critical care (1 Dipl. ECVECC), diagnostic imaging (3 Dipl. ECVDI), dermatology (1 Dipl. ECVD), reproduction (1 Dipl. ECAR), ophthalmology (1 Dipl. ECVO) and nutrition (1 Dipl. ECVN).
