### **Consultant Requirements:**

A current veterinary license in good standing is required. ECVIM/ACVIM board-certification are preferred, but non boarded veterinarians with extensive clinical experience and other advanced qualifications in Oncology may also be considered for this role. Fluency in English and Spanish is preferred, but candidates who are fluent in French, Italian or German in addition to English are also encouraged to apply.

### **Consultant Responsibilities:**

- Be accessible for client consultations during regular working hours.
- Provide telephone consultations to IDEXX customers on small-animal oncology cases
- Be knowledgeable about tests offered by IDEXX Laboratories with particular focus on testing related to oncologic diseases, including histopathology reports, cytology reports, mast cell prognostic panel, immunohistochemistry, flow cytometry, and PARR. Be able to provide guidance to customers on appropriate sample collection, clinical utility and interpretation of each test.

- Familiar with in-house diagnostic (IHD) tests offered by IDEXX (i.e., SNAP tests, VetTest, CatalystDX, Lasercyte, ProCyte, etc).
- Enter consultation information into the Customer Relationship Management System software per expectations.
- Attend at least one continuing education meeting per year for professional development and maintain familiarity with current literature in the field of veterinary oncology.
- Maintain country specific Veterinary Licensure and active Diplomate status (where applicable).
- Participate in scheduled consulting service meetings via teleconference; and to participate in other IDEXX educational or organizational meetings as they arise.
