It is a brand new hospital opened in April 2018 located in a 2500 m² building. At ADVETIA we are a vibrant and happy team of dedicated veterinarians and nurses with a goal to provide the best possible care and service to our patients and clients. If you are interested in joining our team we will be happy to hear from you.

At ADVETIA we have board-certified veterinarians in the following specialties: Anesthesia-Analgesia, Cardiology, Surgery, Dentistry and Oro-maxillo-facial Surgery, Dermatology, Diagnostic Imaging, Internal Medicine, Neurology-Neurosurgery, Small Mammals and Exotic Species medicine and surgery and Oncology. We also currently have 11 residents in training.

The emergency/out of hours service operates 24h/7 with a team of dedicated veterinarians and nurses.

The Medicine team is headed by Dr. Olivier Dossin (dip ECVIM-Internal Medicine, PhD) and is composed of three senior clinicians (including one ECVIM- CA diplomate, one ACVIM and ECVIM-CA diplomate and one ECVIM-CA residency trained clinician), one ECVIM-CA (Internal Medicine resident) and three junior clinicians. The internal medicine case load is growing up very fast and our clinical activity has the support of all specialists in other disciplines and a team of outstanding nurses. Among the equipment available at ADVETIA you will find an endoscopy suite for digestive, respiratory and urinary endoscopy, digital radiography, fluoroscopy, three state of the art HD ultrasound machines (including one dedicated to echocardiography), a multi-slice CT scan, a 1.5 T MRI machine. We have vast wards to hospitalize our patients under state of the art monitoring.
