



The Division of Small Animal Internal Medicine, Small Animal Clinic, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Ghent, Belgium is looking for a:

Resident in companion animal internal medicine (October 1st 2024– 2027).

This will be a full time training program.

Although speaking Dutch is an advantage, it is not mandatory. Willingness to learn Dutch (basics) is a must. Our residency-training program is approved by the ECVIM-ca.

The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of the University of Ghent has a modern hospital. We are located approximately 2 hours from the University of Utrecht (Netherlands) and from the University of Liège (Belgium). The hospital is well-equipped (endoscopy (gastro intestinal, respiratory and cystoscopy), Xray, MRI, CT, ultrasound, scintigraphy, radioactive iodine,...). Caseload for small animals is around 12 000 cases a year. The actual team includes; 8 dipl. ECVIM-ca (one also ACVIM (Internal Medicine), 6 in Internal medicine and 2 in cardiology), 2 ECVN neurologist, 4 ECVDI radiologists, 4 ECVS surgeons, 1 ECVD and ACVD dermatologist, an oncologist, a dentist, 5 residents in Internal Medicine, residents in Radiology, Surgery, Neurology, Dermatology, Cardiology and 10 rotating interns.
