



The Small Animal Hospital (CHUVAC) of the Veterinary Campus of VetAgro-Sup, Lyon, France is opening the following position :

Resident in small animal oncology

This 3-year ECVIM-CA approved medical oncology residency program, **starting on January 2, 2025**, is designed to provide advanced clinical training in oncology in preparation for ECVIM-CA (Oncology) certification.

The program, under the direction of Pr. Frédérique Ponce (ECVIM-CA) and Dr. Laura Barrett (ACVIM-Oncology) encompasses responsibility in oncology and internal medicine cases and includes internal and external rotations in other specialties. Diplomates of different specialties are available on-site (internal medicine, surgery, ECC, clinical pathology, anatomic pathology, anesthesiology, radiology, dermatology). Residents will participate in primary patient care of canine and feline oncology and internal medicine cases, teach students and interns rotating through the oncology service, participate in clinical research projects, and present at weekly journal clubs and monthly book clubs. Residents will give yearly presentations at an in-house residents' seminar as well as at least 2 oral presentations at international conferences (ESVONC and/or ECVIM).

Applicants must have successfully completed a 12-month rotating internship or have gained equivalent experience during at least two years in small animal practice and showed special interest in oncology. The candidate must have good professional working proficiency in both the French and English languages.

Applications should contain:

- i) a personal statement
- ii) a curriculum vitae
- iii) transcripts of all veterinary studies
- iv) three letters of recommendation

Selected candidates will be invited to interview with the Recruitment Committee in **late October 2024**. The residency program will **begin on January 2nd, 2025**.
