

Position Available: Resident in Small Animal Internal Medicine

Hospital Veterinario Puchol, a leading small animal veterinary hospital located in Madrid, Spain, is excited to announce an opening for a Residency position in Small Animal Internal Medicine under the direction of Dr. Isabel Rodríguez (DipECVIM-CA, Internal Medicine).

This position is part of a 3-year, ECVIM-CA (European College of Veterinary Internal Medicine - Companion Animals) approved residency programme designed to provide advanced training in internal medicine. The programme aims to prepare the candidate for certification as a European Veterinary Specialist in Small Animal Internal Medicine and is designed to enhance clinical proficiency in diagnosing, treating, and managing internal medical diseases in companion animals.

Programme Overview:

- **Duration:** 3 years (36 months)
- **Structure:** The residency includes both internal and external rotations across various specialties. The hospital hosts Diplomates in multiple fields, including internal medicine, oncology, cardiology, neurology, ophthalmology, and anesthesiology, providing a rich multidisciplinary environment for comprehensive training.
- **Responsibilities:** Residents will be actively involved in the primary care of second opinion and referral cases for canine and feline patients. The programme also includes participation in clinical research projects, regular attendance and presentations at weekly journal and book clubs. Residents will give presentations at an in-house interns and residents seminar as well as at least two oral presentations at national or international congresses.

Qualifications:

- **Experience:** Candidates must have successfully completed a 12-month rotating internship or have equivalent experience, with at least 2 years in small animal practice and showed special interest in internal medicine.
- **Language Proficiency:** A good professional working proficiency in both Spanish and English languages is required.
- **Additional Skills:** Previous research experience, completion of a specialty internship, and a high degree of motivation will be highly valued.
