

Capital City Specialty & Emergency Animal Hospital is looking to add a full-time cardiologist (residency-trained and residents are also welcome to apply). The service currently supports a cardiologist (myself) along with two dedicated technicians (one cardio-boarded) and a technician assistant. Our hospital opened last year and is already the largest in the region, and continues to grow. A new expansion is almost complete, which will give the Cardio department two dedicated echo rooms, a large work space, and two dedicated exam rooms. There is also opportunity for a specialty training program if interested (cardiology residency or internship).

Our team has a strong focus on client service, patient care, and life-work balance; we are looking for an individual who shares our values. An interest in interventional cardiology is a plus but not required. Equipment includes a Philips CVx with 3D TTE and TEE probes, with funding allocated for a second machine of your choosing. ECG, Holter monitors, and a Medtronic pacemaker programmer are also on-site. We have a spacious, well-stocked cardiac catheterization lab that includes motorized C-Arm fluoroscopy, power injector for angiography, and invasive hemodynamics (Philips Xper Flex Cardio). A 64-slice CT with dedicated power injector is also present for vascular studies.
