Our Hospital

ARH Brisbane opened in 2017 in a 1,400sqm (~15,000 sqft) facility. The hospital is equipped with Olympus flexible endoscopy equipment, Phillips Affinity ultrasound machines, Fuji DR suite, Siemens 64 slice CT and 1.5T MRI. We also have a new dedicated critical care unit equipped with GE ventilators, high flow oxygen therapy and point of care ultrasound.

A fully equipped on-site lab offers haematology, chemistry, blood gas, and coagulation capabilities.

The Position
