

Clinical Assistant or Associate Faculty Position Small Animal Internal Medicine

Job Summary

Purdue University College of Veterinary Medicine (PVM), Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences (VCS), invites applications for one full-time (12 month) Clinical-Track faculty position in Small Animal Internal Medicine at the Assistant or Associate Professor level. Purdue University has a strong existing program in Small Animal Internal Medicine, and the successful applicant will join a team of six ACVIM-boarded internists with interest areas in nephrology/urology, endocrinology, gastroenterology, immune-mediated disease, infectious diseases and infection control. The section works with and is well-supported by a team of board-certified specialists in other areas including anesthesiology, behavior, cardiology, clinical and anatomic pathology, dermatology, diagnostic imaging, emergency and critical care, microbiology, neurology, oncology, ophthalmology, surgery, and toxicology. Excellent available equipment includes two Phoenix dialysis units for intermittent hemodialysis, one Prismaflex unit for continuous renal replacement therapy and therapeutic plasma exchange, Olympus and Storz endoscopes, laparoscopic liver biopsy equipment, urodynamics instruments, holmium laser, 64-slice CT scanner, and 1.5T MRI. The department has separate dedicated spaces for hemodialysis and endourology procedures. Minimally invasive procedures are a strong part of the hospital's services. PVM is highly supportive of individual faculty career growth and development. A formal faculty mentoring program is in place.

- Board certification or completion of a Small Animal Internal Medicine residency program registered by the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine (ACVIM) or the European College of Veterinary Internal Medicine (ECVIM). Experience in nephrology and endourology procedures is preferred.
