THE OFFER

The Small Animal Teaching Hospital of the University of Liège, Belgium, offers a position for a Senior Clinician in Medical Oncology and/or Radiation Oncology. He/she will be part of the oncology team which comprises 1 ECVS dip, 1 consultant, 1 PhD researcher, 1 junior clinician and specialized interns. Part-time position is possible. Development of research activity is a possibility.



THE CLINIC

The Small Animal Teaching Hospital is a state-of-the art facility equipped with the most advanced equipment including 1.5 Tesla MRI, 64 slices CT scan, radiation therapy, electrochemotherapy, endoscopy, minimally invasive equipment, diode laser, blood bank, extracorporeal therapies, mechanical ventilation, among others. Case load for companion animals is around 15.000 cases a year.

The current team includes diplomates in internal medicine (5 ECVIM-CA), diagnostic imaging (4 ECVDI), surgery (3 ECVS), anesthesiology (2 ECVA and 1 ACVA), emergency and intensive care (2 ECVECC), reproduction (2 ECAR), cardiology (2 ECVIM-CA cardiology), ophthalmology (1 ECVO), neurology (1 ECVN), sport medicine and rehabilitation (1 ECVSMR) and nutrition (1 ECVCN).



CANDIDATE PROFILE

Ideally, candidates are expected to be EBVS or ABVS Specialist in Medical Oncology or Radiation Oncology or to be Board eligible.

Proficiency in the French language is essential (B2 level). Effective communication and interpersonal skills are essential attributes, as the role requires collaboration within a team-oriented environment.
