

Full-time Senior Clinician position in Companion Animal Internal Medicine

The Department of Clinical Sciences of Companion Animals, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, ULiège (Belgium), invites applications for a full-time Senior Clinician position in Companion Animal Internal Medicine. The position is open to ECVIM-CA/ACVIM residency-trained clinicians or diplomates. The expected start date is **September 15, 2026**.

Applicants should have a good working knowledge of both French and English.

The successful candidate will have primary clinical responsibility for companion animal internal medicine referral cases. Responsibilities include clinical teaching of undergraduate veterinary students and supervision of residents in companion animal internal medicine, as well as specialized interns and rotating interns. The clinician will also participate in the supervision of internal medicine cases hospitalized through the emergency service. This role does not include first line emergency duty.

The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of the ULiège is located outside the city centre on the edge of the Ardennes region. The faculty benefits from a modern, well equipped companion animal hospital (built in 2019), including an intensive care unit (mechanical ventilation, plasmapheresis, haemodialysis), digital radiography, ultrasonography, CT scan, MRI, and advanced endoscopy for gastrointestinal, respiratory, and urogenital procedures, as well as urethral pressure profilometry. The annual caseload is approximately 13,000 cases per year, including approximately 10,000 dogs and 3,000 cats. The team includes diplomates in companion animal internal medicine (3 Dipl. ECVIM-CA and 1 Dipl. ACVIM), cardiology (2 Dipl. ECVIM-CA (cardiology)), neurology (1 part time Dipl. ECVN), surgery (4 Dipl. ECVS), emergency and critical care (2 Dipl. ECVECC), diagnostic imaging (3 Dipl. ECVDI), reproduction (1 Dipl. ECAR), ophthalmology (2 Dipl. ECVO), anaesthesiology (2 Dipl. ECVA and 1 Dipl. ACVA), and nutrition (1 Dipl. ECVN).
