The Royal (Dick) School of Veterinary Studies has superb facilities at the Easter Bush Campus, nestled at the foot of the Pentland Hills, within very easy reach of the vibrant capital city of Edinburgh and with beautiful Scottish countryside to the north and south.

We are seeking a Senior Lecturer/Lecturer in Small Animal Cardiology. As part of a team covering all aspects of small animal cardiology, you will assist in the provision of a referral level Small Animal Cardiology Service at the Royal (Dick) School of Veterinary Studies and contribute to the teaching efforts of the Service and assist in the development of the Cardiology Service. Working in a multidisciplinary environment where collaboration is actively encouraged, you will be supported by teams of specialists in internal medicine, oncology, anaesthesia, soft tissue surgery, orthopaedics, ophthalmology, neurology, emergency and critical care among others.

The Head of the Cardiology service is Professor Geoff Culshaw. Including Geoff, there are four senior staff, three of whom hold DipECVIM, and the other the RCVS Diploma. Cardiology has two residents, two dedicated nurses, and an animal care assistant. The Hospital has a great team of dedicated staff, keen to provide cross disciplinary support.

This post is full-time (35 hours per week) for a fixed term of 9 months.

The salary for this post is £50,253-£61,759 (UE08) or £63,606-£78,469 (UE09) per annum according to experience plus Market Force Supplement (reviewed annually, currently 8%).
